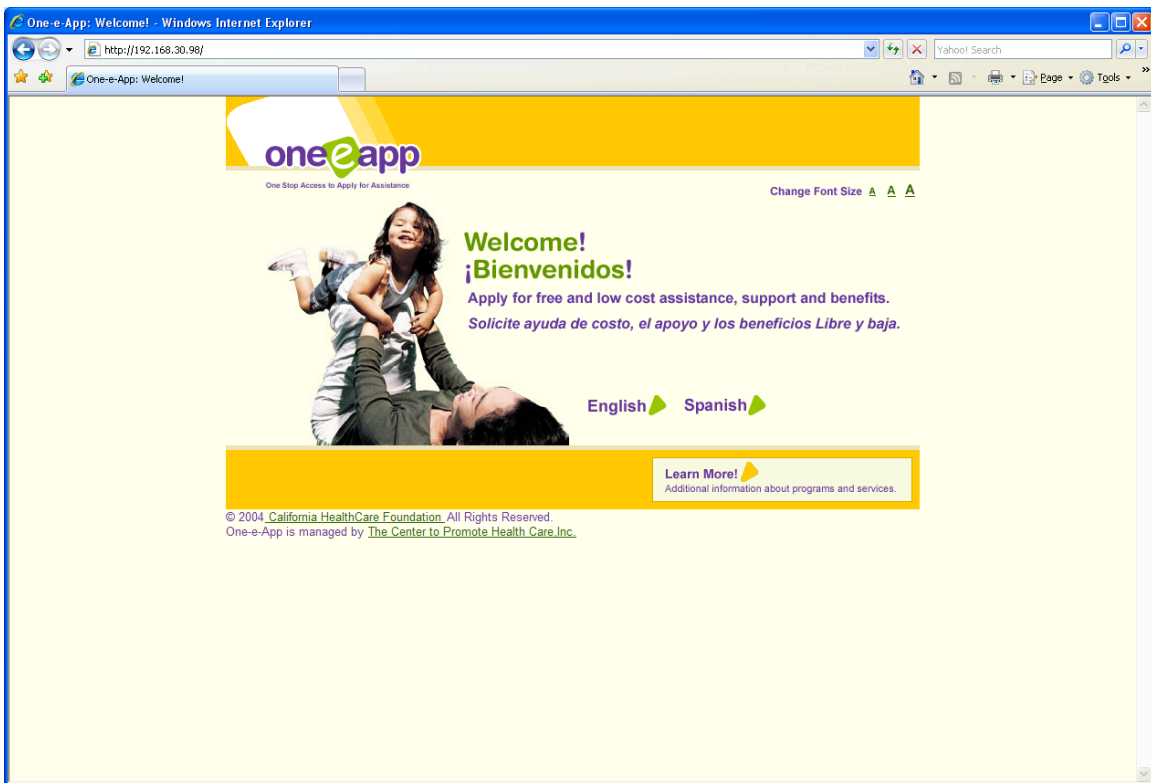




One-e-App is an innovative Web-based system for connecting families with a range of public benefits such as Medicaid, SCHIP, Food Stamps, Earned Income Tax Credit, WIC and others. One-e-App collects information from families at *one* time for *all* programs and delivers applications electronically wherever possible. One-e-App software is used in Arizona (Health-e-Arizona), California (One-e-App), Indiana (Ind-e-App) and Maryland (Health-e-Link) by community assistors, county and state eligibility staff and the public themselves. One-e-App reforms the application process for applicants, many of whom navigate a complex maze of referrals and handoffs when seeking needed services. The system creates efficiencies for government by reducing errors, speeding the eligibility process and removing the need for repetitive manual data entry.
